CONFIDENTIAL ANNEX

The Accused will be released to the Republic of Serbia as soon as possible on the following conditions:

THE CHAMBER

ORDERS the Accused:

- 1) to hand over his passport to the authorities of the Republic of Serbia upon his arrival;
- 2) to have no contact of any kind with the victims, witnesses or to try to influence them in any way;
- 3) not to obstruct, in any way, the procedure or the course of justice;
- 4) to appear before the Chamber when ordered to do so;

CALLS on the authorities of the Republic of Serbia:

- 1) not to issue a new passport to the Accused allowing him to travel without the permission of the Chamber;

REQUESTS that the Registrar of the Tribunal:

- 1) consult the authorities of the Kingdom of the Netherlands with regard to the practicalities involved in the release of the Accused;
- 2) keep the Accused in detention until the measures necessary for his travel are in place;
- 3) transmit this decision to the appropriate authorities.

REQUESTS that the authorities of the Kingdom of the Netherlands:

- 1) take the Accused to Schiphol airport (or another airport in the Kingdom of the Netherlands) on the day of his release;
- 2) take custody of the Accused upon his return when so ordered by the Chamber and transport him to the United Nations Detention Unit.

REQUESTS that, if necessary, the authorities of the transit States:

- 1) ensure the safety of the Accused while he is in transit at the airport;
- 2) arrest the Accused, should he attempt to escape, and detain him while awaiting his transfer to the United Nations Detention Unit.
